### **Director of Field Education**

The University of Georgia School of Social Work (SSW) invites applicants for the position of Director of Field Education. The Director provides leadership and supervision of the Field Education Office and program and oversees the placement of approximately 300 BSW and MSW students each year in compliance with Council of Social Work Education standards for field education. Responsibilities include evaluation of student learning and field placements congruent with SSW competencies. The Director is also responsible for the development of new field education/research placement opportunities and the successful maintenance of relationships with existing agency partners. He/she serves as a member of the Dean's Administrative Committee and advises the Dean, the MSW and BSW Program Directors, and the faculty on matters pertaining to field instruction.

Applicants must have an MSW degree and 3-5 years post-MSW social work experience. Individuals with doctoral degrees are encouraged to apply. Candidates must have prior experience in field education and student supervision, in addition to administrative experience.

The School of Social Work offers accredited BSW and MSW programs in addition to a doctorate in Social Work. It is ranked among the leading schools of social work in the nation offering both full and part-time educational opportunities for an internationally diverse population of traditional and non-traditional students.
