Qualified applicants should possess an MSW from a CSWE-accredited program, a minimum of 3 years post-MSW practice experience and experience in clinical supervision. Experience in field education is preferred. LCSW in the State of Georgia required. Responsibilities include individual and group supervision to MSWs preparing for licensure; field liaison responsibilities; coordination and reporting in compliance with funding requirements; teaching integrative field seminars; recruitment and evaluation of appropriate field learning sites; and training field instructors. The position will be based at our Athens campus with extensive travel to field sites in Milledgeville and Savannah required. This Academic Professional Associate faculty position consists of a renewable annual appointment contingent upon satisfactory performance.
